Looks like an 11" x 17" flip chart

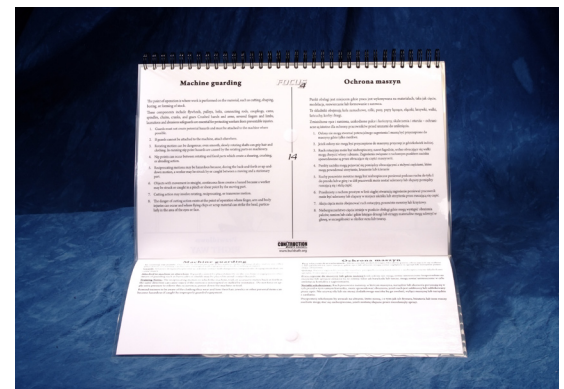
Contains 16 short, separate topics/lessons in Construction Focus Four hazards with illustrations and training notes (training topics are listed on the back)

Available in either English/Spanish or English/Polish

Trainer can be anyone who speaks Spanish or Polish; trainer needs no construction experience.

Each participant receives a small pocket-size book that covers all topics. Each kit comes with 10 student booklets. Additional booklets are available upon request.

It is not necessary to cover every topic, only what is needed.



The Only Requirements:

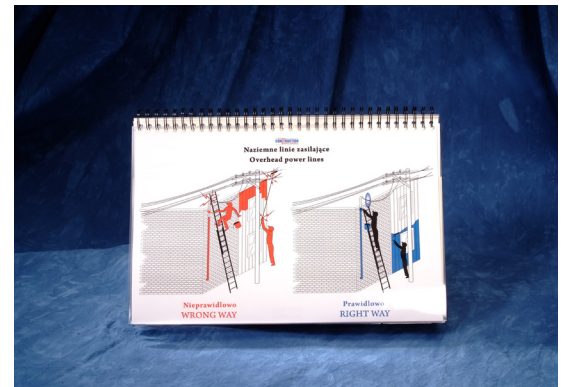
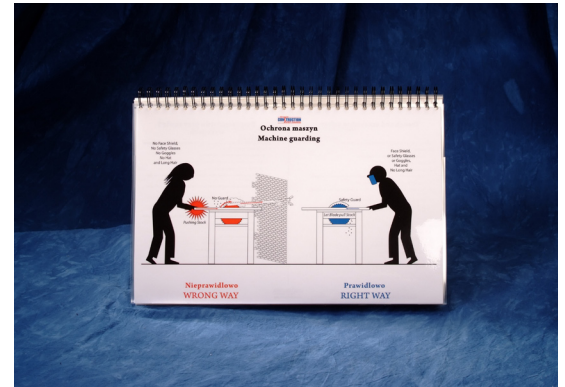
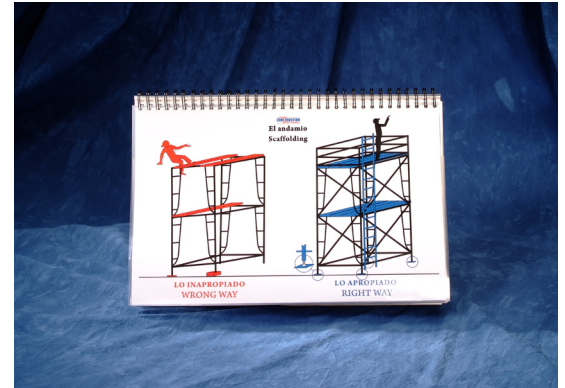
